

Concerned about COVID-19? Let's work together!

Here's what we're doing to keep you healthy:

- Until further notice we will implement a new cleaning procedure for the wellness equipment
 - Each piece of equipment will have two cards attached to it.
 - If you see a green card on the equipment that says it has been sanitized and is ready to be used, GO ahead and use the equipment.
 - o If you see an orange card on the equipment, STOP! Do not use! This equipment has not been sanitized and is not ready for use.
 - When you are finished using the equipment, please place the orange card on the equipment. Then take the green card to a CYCC staff member to cue them to sanitize the equipment.
 - When they are done, they will place the green card back on the equipment & it is ready to use again. If you do not see a green card on the equipment, do not use!
 - o Please continue to use the gym wipes for dumbbells, bands, balls, etc.
- We already use a hospital grade quaternary disinfectant every night and will increase sanitization of commonly touched surfaces throughout the day
- Supplying additional hand sanitizer pumps around the Wellness Center

Here's how you can help keep our community healthy:

- Please be patient & courteous! This new cleaning procedure may require a small wait time to use the equipment you want to use.
- **DO NOT** come to the community center if you or a family member is experiencing fever, dry cough, or shortness of breath OR if any of you have been exposed to anyone experiencing these symptoms or is known to have a positive diagnosis of COVID-19.
- Wash your hands often with soap & water for at least 20 seconds
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue or your elbow and immediately wash your hands
- Maintain social distancing
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, & mouth
